On Wednesday, 11/7, and Friday, 11/9, we will be watching the film *Stranger Than Fiction* in Creative Writing class. This film is about a man whose life turns out to be the plot of a novel, and he goes in search of the author/narrator before she can kill him off. This film not only is an interesting look at the writing process, but also touches on several concepts we will be studying in our unit on fiction and drama. Because a copy of this film is not owned by the district, I am required to get permission forms from parents of all my students, regardless of their age or ability to see the film on their own. This film is rated PG-13 "for some disturbing images, sexuality, brief language and nudity" (the nudity is a brief, non-sexual scene in which two men walk through a locker room and other men can be seen showering in the background). Students who do not have the permission form submitted by the start of the film will be given an alternate, reading assignment.
