1. Read the story “Cranes” on p. 222 of your lit textbook. Then, on a separate piece of paper, identify, as best you can:
  - a. Components of plot (exposition, complications, climax, resolution)
  - b. Examples of direct and indirect characterization
  - c. The narrator point of view
  - d. The theme of the story
  - e. Irony and/or ambiguity present in the story
  - f. Symbolism present in the story
  
2. Read the poems “Woman Work” on p. 409 and “Daily” on p. 410. Then, on a separate piece of paper, for each poem:
  - a. Paraphrase the poem in your own words
  - b. Identify examples of imagery in the poem
  - c. Identify examples of poetic sounds in the poem (rhyme, alliteration, assonance, repetition, etc.)
  - d. Identify examples of figurative language in the poem (simile, metaphor, personification, etc.)
